

2007-2008 MAHA/AllTel Center Working Rules

1. MAHA participants are to enter through the Riverfront Drive doors only.
2. The loading area on Riverfront is for DROP OFF ONLY, no parking is available. Police WILL tow.
3. All parking will be in the Depot Ramp. Enter off of Riverfront or Walnut. The ramp is not attended after 6:00 so there is no charge.
4. NO PARKING will be allowed in the Suite lot (Chamber lot).
5. Doors will be opened 30 minutes prior to the first practice, and locked 30 minutes after the last practice each night.
6. Spectator seating is in sections 117-120 below the blue gates only.
7. No climbing is allowed on the railing or gates. Please do not sit on the dashers. Violators will be asked to leave immediately and may jeopardize MAHA's ability to use the facility in the future.
8. The on-duty event manager will be found in section 120. This person is the contact person for the facility.
9. Dressing rooms 136, 128, and 127 are available to be used. 136 and 128 no longer have lockers available.
10. No unattended children are allowed in the building.
11. A "key" individual from each team is to contact the event manager when they arrive. The event manager will go through this person if any issue arise, and vice versa. The event manager will have a cell phone available for contact purposes.
12. MAHA needs to provide a person to over see the locker rooms. The AllTel Center is NOT responsible for items left in this area or any items taken from this area. Supervision is needed until the teams take the ice, at which time the locker rooms can be locked by the event manager IF ASKED by a MAHA supervisor.
13. Restrooms are located in the locker room area.
14. MAHA parents are to run the scoreboard during games (AllTel Center will provide training). It is up to MAHA to inform AllTel of these games one full week in advance. This request needs to come from the team manager, through the Operation's Manager (Dan Devenport).
15. Additional equipment such as cones are available through the event manager. However, the coaches need to contact the event manager in enough time to get this taken care of for practice. NO ONE is allowed in the loading dock area.
16. Vending machines have been re-located to the locker room area...no public access will be allowed other than in the locker room corridor.
